Requirements for portable restrooms and holding tanks, Chapter 64E-6.0101, Florida Administrative Code. The fee for septage disposal service permit is \$110, and \$35 for any additional vehicle(s).

- Tanks used for the servicing portable restroom waste shall be constructed, sized and operated in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 64E-6.010(2)(a)1-3, Florida Administrative Code.
- The servicing company must receive an annual operating permit from the local county health department (form DH 4013) where the company holds its business office.
- The vehicle must have the following information permanently displayed with 3 inch or larger letters: permit number, name of the company, phone number, gallon capacity. THE USE OF MAGNETIC REMOVABLE SIGNS IS NOT ADEQUATE VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION. In addition, the applicant must possess adequate equipment to perform the intended work, to include: tank truck, pumps, off truck stabilization tanks and pH testing equipment where lime stabilization and land application are proposed.
- Portable restroom and holding tank haulers must maintain a collection and hauling log at the main business location with the following information. Records are to be retained for a minimum of 5 years.
 - Date of septage or waste collection
 - Estimated volume of septage or waste transported in gallons.
 - Location of the approved treatment facility
 - Date and time of discharge to the treatment facility
 - Acknowledgement from treatment facility of receipt of septage or waste

Portable holding tank facilities shall be inspected by the local CHD to ensure proper maintenance of equipment, observe required sanitation standards, and check hauling log.

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
